# Information for parents or carers

If your child is under 16, you will need to give them permission to complete the survey.

#### The process involves:

- First confirming that yourself and your child are happy to complete the survey.
- Answering a series of optional questions about your child and family on their behalf. All responses will be kept strictly anonymous, and cannot be linked back to you or your family.
- Hand over the survey for your child to complete. They
  will also be asked if they are happy to complete the
  survey and will be given a list of organisations that
  provide support for issues around violence raised in
  the survey.
