

Keep in the Know Durham and Darlington is a free messaging service brought to you by Durham Constabulary where you decide when and how you are kept informed about the issues that matter to you.

Register your details to receive regular neighbourhood alerts with crime updates and details of other issues that matter to you.

The alerts will come straight into your email inbox, so once you are signed up you don't need to keep checking back for updates, you will receive them automatically.







Click on sign up and follow the steps to register your details to receive alerts.

Registration is quick, simple and completely free and if you change your mind, you can unsubscribe at any time.

Keep In The Know is a free service that allows the police and selected partners to send you information and updates about what is happening in your area.



Altogether Better Policing

The system allows you to choose who you wish to receive messages from and what subjects interest you, this means that the only messages that you will get are the only ones that are relevant to you. You can log into the system at any time and change your preferences so that you can manage what you receive as your needs or interests change.

During the registration process you will have the opportunity to review and select additional licensed information providers who will, if authorised by you, be able to see your data and send you messages. Although all the information providers listed may not be actively using the system at this time, you will be notified as they come on board. You can remove any information provider at any time.



Your personal details will be securely held under the provisions of the Data Protection Act. As a registered recipient you may also hear about good news stories in your community or we may appeal for information to help us identify suspected or wanted criminals or suspect vehicles. If we are appealing for information we may provide an officers name and contact details at the bottom of a message you can contact the officer directly or if you choose to reply directly to the Keep In The Know message we will ensure that your message is passed onto that officer.

Please note that Keep In the Know is not monitored 24/7 and is not for reporting crimes or incidents.

You can report a crime by calling the non-emergency number 101 or in the case of an emergency dial 999.
